SURFACE PREPARATION

Prior to applying Bostik N40 Primer the substrate must be sound, dry, clean and free from any dust, residue or contamination and meet the requirements of substrate preparation detailed in the applicable Sealant or membrane Technical Data Sheet. Bostik primers, sealants or membranes must not be applied to unpredictable absorptive surfaces such as marble, limestone or granite unless a standard of appearance has been agreed upon as a result of testing for stain and/or discoloration.

APPLICATION

Two Cloth Method

 Dampen a clean cloth with Bostik N40 Primer and spread evenly over the non-porous substrate using a

cleaning/rubbing action

- With a second clean cloth, immediately wipe all primer residues off with a buffing action
- Allow the substrate to dry for a minimum of 5 minutes before installing the backing rod, sealant/adhesive or waterproof membrane system
- Do not leave the primer longer than 4 hours before applying sealant/adhesive
- Re-prime if 4 hours has elapsed without applying sealant/adhesive

LIMITATIONS

- Provide adequate ventilation during application
- For use on non-porous rigid plastic and ferrous and non-ferrous substrates only
- The primed substrate must be clean and dry, e.g. no free or ponded water or condensation, before the sealant/adhesive or membrane system is applied
- Re-prime if affected by rain, dust or other contaminants after application
- Use only on recommended substrates, refer substrate primer guide
- Do not apply at temperatures below 5°C or above 35°C
- Do not dilute or mix with other solvents or primers

CLEANING

Mop up spills with cloth or paper. Clean up with Bostik Handy Wipes.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store in cool, dry conditions out of direct sunlight below 30°C and away from naked flame or sources of heat. Store according to Dangerous Goods regulations. Shelf life is 12 months if stored in cool, dry conditions in original, unopened containers.

DISPOSAL

Empty containers, once dry, may be disposed of via local landfill.

If spilt, beware of flammable vapours. Absorb product with clay, sand or earth. Collect in properly labelled metal containers. Dispose of according to local authority regulations. Do not dispose of down drains or into waterways. Fully dried material is not hazardous.
