



LEAKPROOF DECK & SHOWER

Technical Data Sheet

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Leakproof Deck & Shower is a waterborne flexible waterproofing membrane that meets AS4654,AS4858:2004 and AS3740:2004. Designed for use under tiled finishes it is capable of accommodating expected structural movement.

ACCEPTABLE SUBSTRATES:

- Concrete, precast concrete, bricks, masonry, cement sheet
- Always contact the manufacturer if in any doubt regarding substrates to be bonded

SUBSTRATE PREPARATION:

All surfaces to be waterproofed must be firm, clean, dry, sound and smooth. All grease, oil, wax, curing compounds, dust and any other contaminants must be removed. Fibrous cement sheeting, and/or water resistant plasterboard must be fixed in accordance with the manufacturer's installation

directions. Concrete must be allowed to cure for 28 days and cement render and sand / cement screeds must be allowed to cure for 7 days with moisture content below 5% prior to the application of B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower. Porous substrates with less than 5% moisture content must first be primed using B&L Leakproof Primmix Bond. Damp or moisture sensitive substrates above 5% moisture content must be primed using B&L Leakproof Dampseal Moisture Barrier prior to the application of B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower. Non - porous substrates may require B&L Leakproof Dampseal Moisture Barrier or B&L Leakproof Primmix Bond. Please contact APTC Australia should you require clarification regarding the use of these products. Apply B&L Proflex Hybrid Polymer Sealant as a bond breaker to the wall and floor joints, and wherever there is a change in the direction of the substrate. Sealant joints should be between 6 & 12mm. Joint widths less than 6mm or greater than 12mm will

require B&L Proflex in conjunction with

Once all joints are sealed apply B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower using a brush or roller. A minimum thickness of 1mm dried film thickness is required to achieve AS4858:2004. B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower is not designed to span or fill gaps. A minimum of two coats of B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower is required to achieve a minimum dry film thickness of 1mm.

APTC Leakproof Bandage or APTC Butyl fleece Tape.

DRYING:

Recoat 2 – 4 hours at 25 degrees Celsius. Allow a minimum of 48 hours to dry prior to tiling. Allow longer in adverse weather conditions.

LIMITATIONS:

• B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower is not designed to stop

- a hydrostatic head of water pressure (B&L Leakproof Dampseal Moisture Barrier is recommended)
- B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower must not be used over damp, wet or contaminated substrates
- B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower must not be applied if it is raining or if rain is imminent
- B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower must not be applied directly over protective coatings
- B&L Leakproof Deck & Shower is non trafficable and is not UV stable
- Do not apply where the surface temperature is below 10°C or greater than 35°C

CLEAN UP:

Clean tools and equipment with warm water and detergent while the membrane is still wet.

PACKAGING:

15 litre plastic pails.

COVERAGE:

1.5 - 2 litres per square metre. 2 coats required. Dry Film Thickness 1mm.

SHELF LIFE:

Unopened pails can be stored for up to 12 months in a cool, dry and weatherproof environment.

HEALTH & SAFETY:
